

Plymouth Soccer Association Privacy Policy

At the Plymouth Soccer Association (PSA) our goal is to provide a fun, informative and safe interactive online experience for all of the children and parents within our club. We want you to understand and feel comfortable with our process of gathering information from users, and we want you to know how that information is used and what your rights are with regards to all of the information collected.

The purpose of this Privacy Policy Statement is to inform you about:

- a. what information about you will be collected by PSA and the circumstances under which the information will be collected;
- b. how the information will be used or disclosed to others;
- c. what kind of security procedures are in place to protect against the loss, misuse or unauthorized alteration of information under PSA's control; and
- d. what steps you can take to have inaccuracies in the information corrected.

Disclosure

In the normal course of operations we will maintain personal information on computers in the United States. The United States offers differing levels of protection of personal information. You agree to the transfer of the Information among such computers.

Application

This Privacy Policy Statement applies only to the <http://www.plymouthsoccer.com> and <https://plymouthsoccer.osas.com> web sites and not to Web sites operated and maintained by other organizations to which PSA web sites are linked, or companies with whom you may engage in transactions for the sale of PSA branded products.

Information Collected By The Plymouth Soccer Association

The types of information that PSA may collect about you is limited to the following:

Volunteered Information: This category consists of (i) information that you provide to PSA upon registration of your child for a soccer program, such as your name, email address, occupation, telephone numbers and other contact information, (ii) information that you subsequently provide to PSA regarding your contact information through any password protected features of our web site, or changes in your registration information, (iii) if you are a participant in a PSA soccer event such as tryouts, a coaches clinic or our tournament, the information that you provide to that event at the time of enrollment and thereafter through the event, by you directly entering the information into our web site , and (iv) other information about you that you may voluntarily provide at PSA's request.

Transaction Information: This category consists of information you may provide to PSA as a result of your purchase of goods or services from PSA, which may include contact information, billing and shipping addresses and financial information such as credit card number and expiration date. Information that you may provide to an organization other than PSA during a transaction consummated through the PSA web site is not included in this Privacy Policy Statement and will be subject to the privacy policies and practices, if any, employed by the organization with whom you are dealing.

"Cookie" Information: As is the case with many Web sites, the PSA web site may use standard technology called "cookies," which are small data files that are downloaded onto your computer when you visit our web site. Cookies automatically identify your browser to the PSA server whenever you interact with us. The PSA web site may use cookies to keep track of your preferences, but cannot track any activity by you on other web sites. If you prefer not to have any information collected by cookies, you may disable cookies by turning them off in your browser; however, some areas of the PSA web site may not function properly if you do.

All of these types of information about you may be maintained by the Plymouth Soccer Association on computers located in the United States, and may be transferred from time to time among those computers.

How Information Will Be Used or Shared With Others

Except as provided in this Section, PSA will not use or disclose to any third party any personally identifiable information about you for any purpose without your express prior consent. We will not sell, lease, rent or offer at no cost information to PSA sponsors, advertisers or partner organizations.

Volunteered Information: Volunteered Information will be used by PSA to operate the soccer club and maintain your contact information, including the record of your child's team registration(s), payments and balances owed. For this purpose it will be necessary to disclose Volunteered Information to PSA employees who have a need to know.

Volunteered information may be used by PSA to send you information about PSA, including but not limited to newsletters, registration confirmations and invitations to club wide events.

Volunteered information may be used by PSA to find volunteers for various committees and to support various events (such as tryouts, fund raising or a soccer tournament) in the furtherance of PSA's mission. For this purpose it will be necessary to disclose Volunteered Information to PSA employees and Board members who have a need to know. PSA will make every attempt to combine related information into periodic email communications to our members.

Transaction Information:

Transaction Information will be used by PSA solely for the purpose of completing the transaction you have requested and providing customer service for that transaction. Financial Information such as credit card number and expiration dates will not be stored or saved on our server(s).

Cookie Information:

Cookie Information (which is identified to your browser, and not to you personally) will be used only to assist in your navigation within the PSA web site, to monitor your interest in the information available on the PSA web site, to assist PSA in tailoring the content of our web site to users' needs by collecting information about their preferences through tracking patterns of page-viewing on our web site, and to assist PSA in delivering content that appears to meet your preferences. PSA may be required by court order or legal process to disclose information about you in its possession.

Security Procedures In Place

The PSA web site at www.plymouthsoccer.com is hosted by a service with security procedures in place that are contemporary with other soccer clubs.

The PSA registration database is hosted by servers owned by COGRAN Sports Systems, with security procedures in place that are contemporary with other sports organizations. Access to every player registration in our database is user name and password protected, with the players parents establishing both.
